JULY WORKSHOP WITH FAWN - LANDSCAPES

Fawn earned her BA at UCI, Claire Trevor School of the Arts and her Credential from Concordia University. She worked at Orange County Department of Education, ACCESS Program and taught drawing: pencil, pen & ink, scratch board, pastel and block printing to high-risk youth. Dawn is the recipient of three grants:

Arts Coach: taught basic drawing skills using pencil and pastels at the various ACCESS sites in Orange County. As an arts coach, she held workshops for teachers in the program on how to integrate art into their curriculum.

- ♣ Picerne Foundation, senior art project after school program: taught basic art skills through multiple mediums at two middle schools in Oceanside for one year.

Since retiring in 2015, her focus is developing her art skills. Her favorite medium is oil painting. Fawn's grandmother was a painter, and her dad was a musician and sculptor. Her mom was Samoan and being Polynesian she has learned many of the dances of the Polynesian islands.
