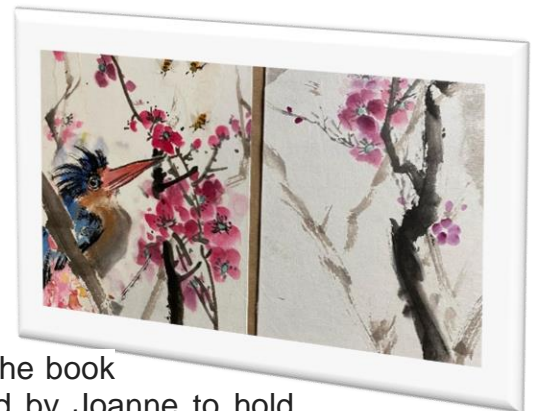

TUESDAY PAINTERS

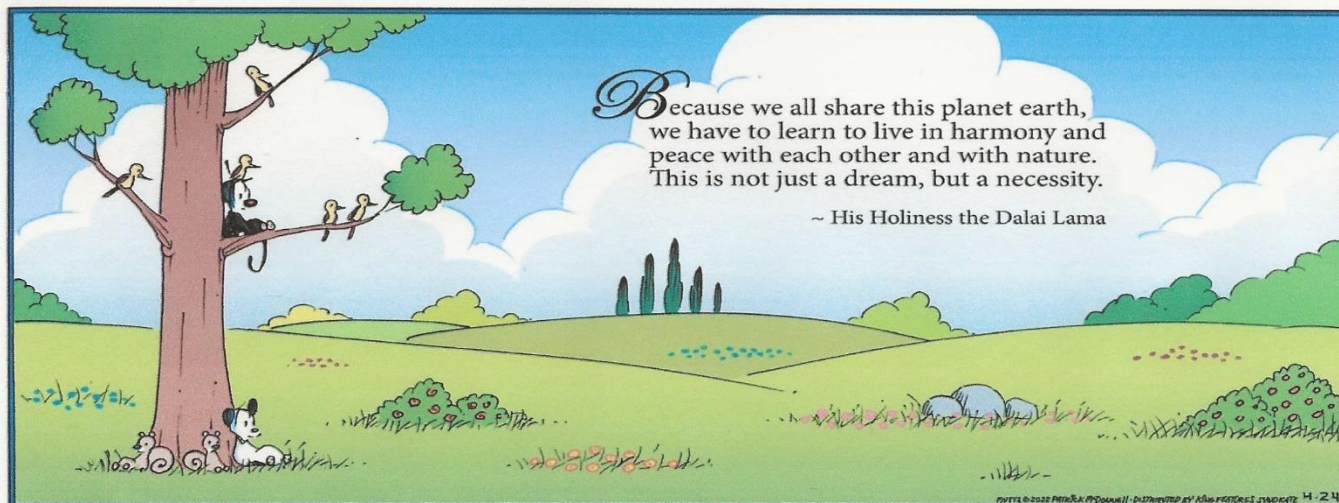

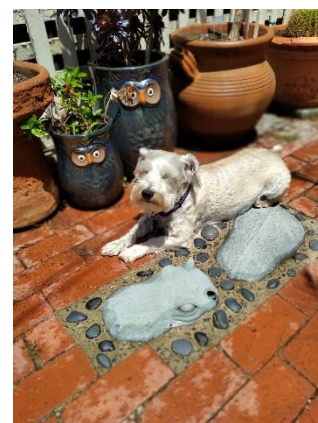
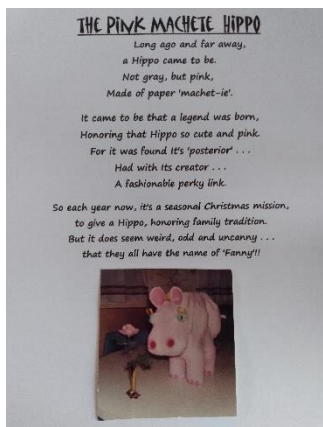
