ART CLUB ANNUAL EXHIBITION (Virtual)



Juror, Judge and Workshop Instructor 3 Day Zoom Online Workshop Dongfeng Li September 9, 10, 11 from 1PM - 4PM EDT

DONGFENG LI was born and raised in China and studied at Tianjin Academy of Fine Arts. He came to the United States in 1992 and subsequently received a Master of Art Education from the University of South Alabama and a Master of Fine Arts from Southern Illinois University. His Chinese brush paintings and watercolors have been exhibited nationally and internationally, including the annual international shows of the Sumi-E Society of America, American Watercolor Society, the National Watercolor Society, Transparent Watercolor Society of America and more than twenty states' watercolor societies in the United States. He is the signature member for American Watercolor Society, a Dolphin Fellowship Member which is the top honor in AWS membership and a member of the National Watercolor Society. His watercolor paintings appear many times in Watercolor Artist Magazine including the Winter 2022 issue. He currently teaches drawing, painting and watercolor at Morehead State University in Morehead, Kentucky. Dongfeng Li believes the aesthetics of calligraphy have had a significant influence on Chinese brush painting in the long history of Chinese art development. The criteria applied to calligraphy is the same for Chinese brush painting: vitality and expressiveness of the brushstroke itself and the harmonious rhythm of the whole composition. It is important to know that the essence of Chinese art is the artist's expression and perception of nature, harmony and personal feelings. "I paint with an eye towards the emotional experience of my subjects. I want to create an intimate relationship between the viewer and the subject. Through use of composition, values and the sense of harmony."
